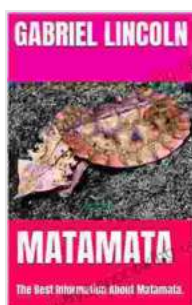


Matamata: The Best Information About Matamata

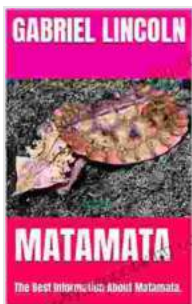

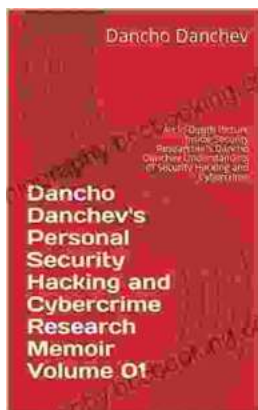
